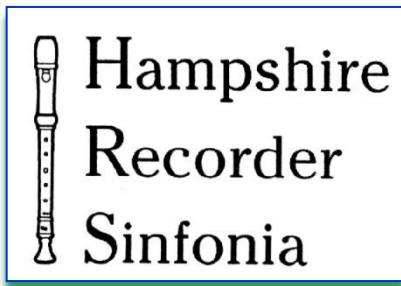

Bring recorders, music stand, pencil, water and a packed lunch and we'll do the rest. Doors open at 9.30 for coffee. Playing starts at 10.00.

The community centre has great facilities, is easily accessible see page 2, has excellent free parking and there's even an on-site Co-op convenience store in case you need to top up your lunch!

HOW TO GET TO COLDEN COMMON COMMUNITY CENTRE

By train. The nearest railway stations are Shawford (limited service, no taxis) and Eastleigh (about 4 km, 2.5 ml) served by South Western Railway. If you arrive at Winchester station you can take a P&R bus from the station to the Broadway (for bus station; see next paragraph).

By bus. The Stagecoach No.69 bus service from Stand E Winchester Bus Station to Fareham passes the Community Centre. Alight at Colden Common Primary School and walk back a few yards to St Vigor Way and the Community Centre. There is an hourly service on Saturday departing Winchester at 13.25 and arriving around 13.46. A service in the opposite direction departs Colden Common around 17.08. It is advisable to check times before travelling (www.stagecoachbus.com).

By car.

1. Approaching from the north on the M3. Leave the M3 at Junction 11 down the slip road at the end of the Twyford cutting. Turn left at traffic lights at the foot of the slip road and follow B3354 to Twyford centre. Continue ahead at the traffic lights in the centre of Twyford. After a further 2.3 km (1.4 ml) on B3354 turn right, just before traffic lights, into Spring Lane. After 600m (0.4 ml) at a mini roundabout turn left into Upper Moors Road and then first left into St Vigor Way after a few yards. The Community Centre is on your left towards the end of the car park
2. Approaching from the south on the M3 (via Southampton or M27): leave the M3 at Junction 12. Cross over the M3 and at roundabout take the second exit (after the southbound M3 slip road) onto A335 signed Eastleigh. At the next roundabout take the first left (B3335; blue 'height limit 1.7m' sign) into Allbrook Hill (caution, narrow road). Cross the next mini roundabout and pass under the railway. Continue ca. 1750m (1.1 ml) then, on a left hand bend, turn right into Spring Lane (signed Colden Common and Rising Sun PH). At mini roundabout turn right into Upper Moors Road and then first left into St Vigor Way after a few yards. The Community Centre is on your left towards the end of the car park.
